

Lynn of the second part all of the County of Prince William and State of Virginia, Witnesseth, that in consideration of Two hundred and forty eight Dollars and forty seven cents (\$248.47) the said party of the first part do grant unto the said party of the second part with General Waranty a certain tract or parcel of land and the appurtenances thereto belonging situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid being part of a patent granted to Leonard Barker in the year 1730 and bounded by a recent survey thereof made by Thos A. Carter as follows: Beginning at A in the Annexed Plat a stone in the western line of Ezekiel Lynn's purchase of Edward Dulow out of said patent, thence with said line 839.16'
