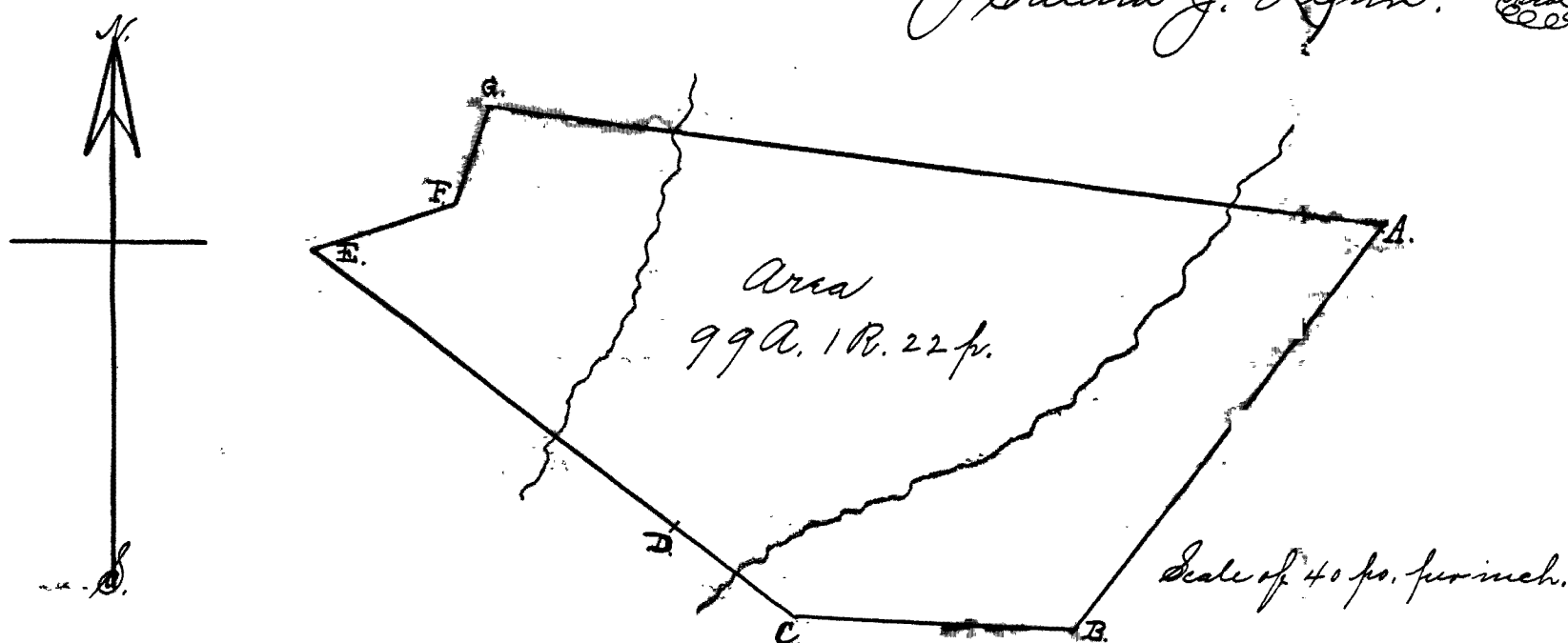

This Indenture Witnesseth That the grantors Jefferson B. Lynn, and Salina J. Lynn his wife of the town of Savanna, in the county of Carroll and state of Illinois; for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five (\$125.00) dollars, in hand paid, convey and warrant to James Leo Kindeloe, of the town of Savanna, county of Carroll, and state of Illinois, the following described real estate, to wit:— Being part of a patent, granted to Leonard Barker in the year 1730, and bounded by a recent survey thereof, made by Thos. H. Carter, as follows:— Beginning at A in the annexed plat, a stone in the western line of Ezekiel Lynn's purchase of Edward Dublin, out of said patent, thence with said line S. 39° 16' N. 115 poles to B, a natural first stone, to said purchase, and on the north line of the purchase of Moses Lynn of H. D. Towell out of said patent, thence with said line, N. 85° 1/4 N. 58.4 poles to C, a stone pile on a north west hill side, corner to said purchase and a patent of said Barker and George Enos, thence with the line of said patent crossing a branch, N. 53° 13' N. 27.8 poles (28 poles called for) to D, another stone pile corner to said patent, and the lands of said E.
